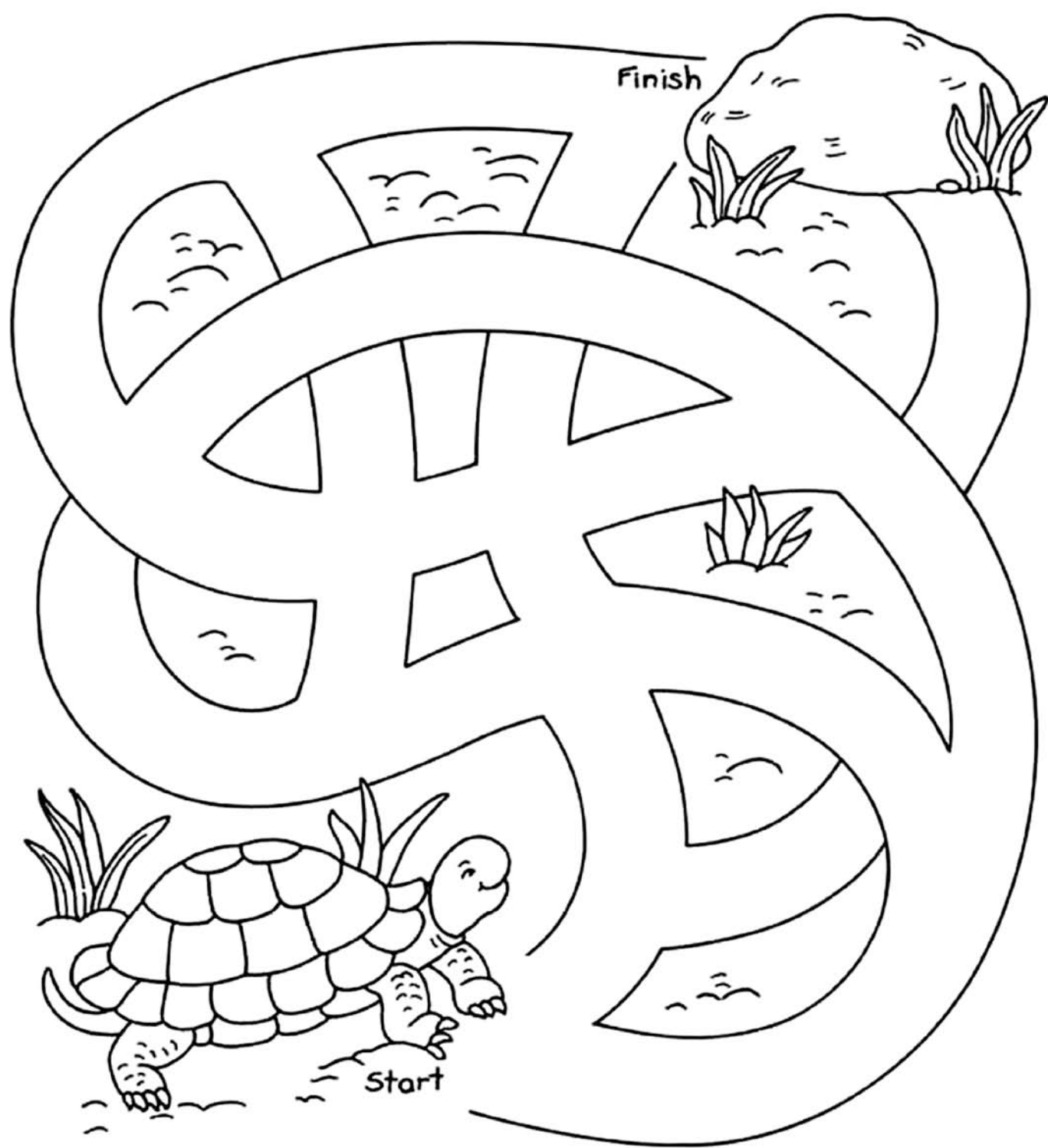

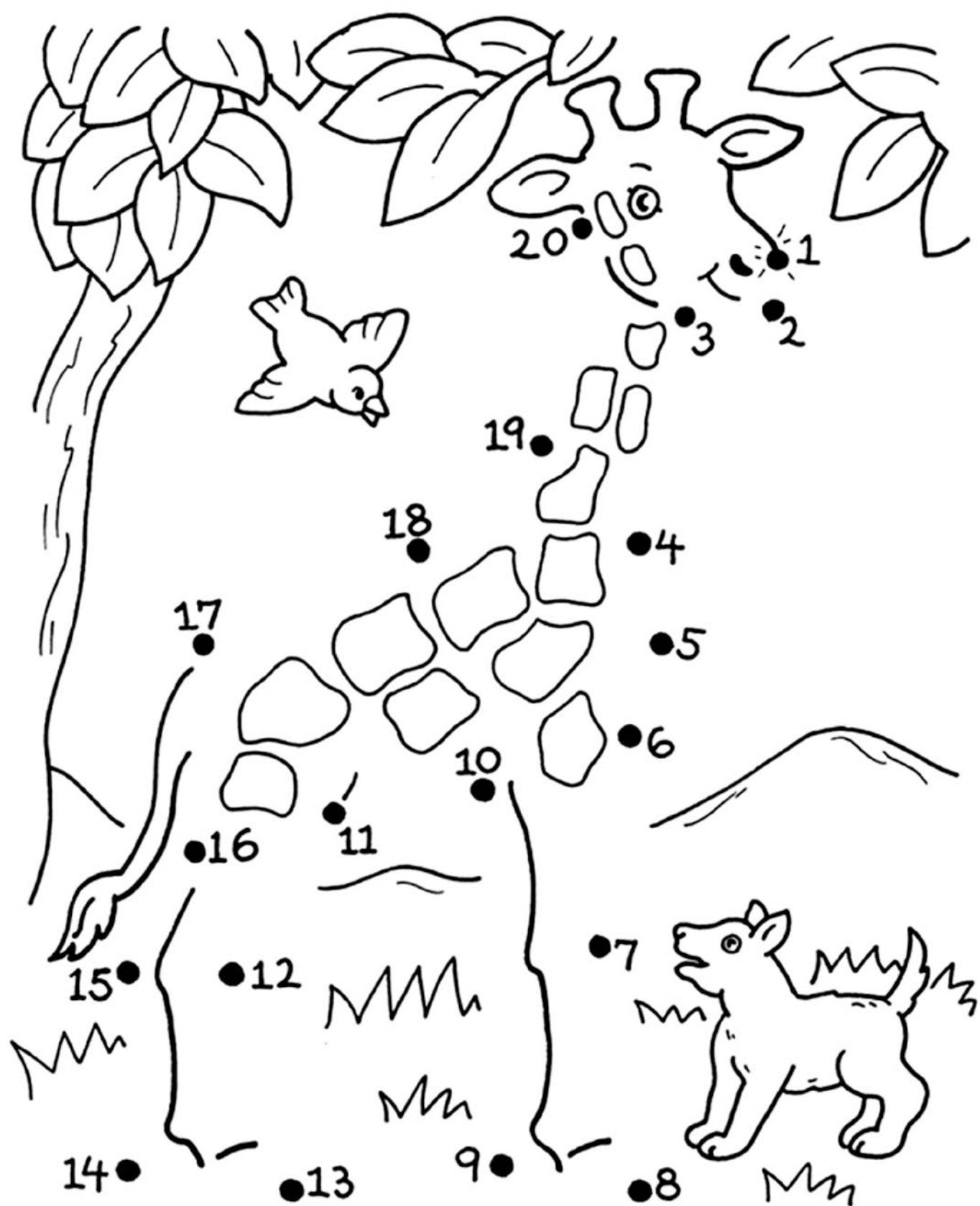
Busy Bugs

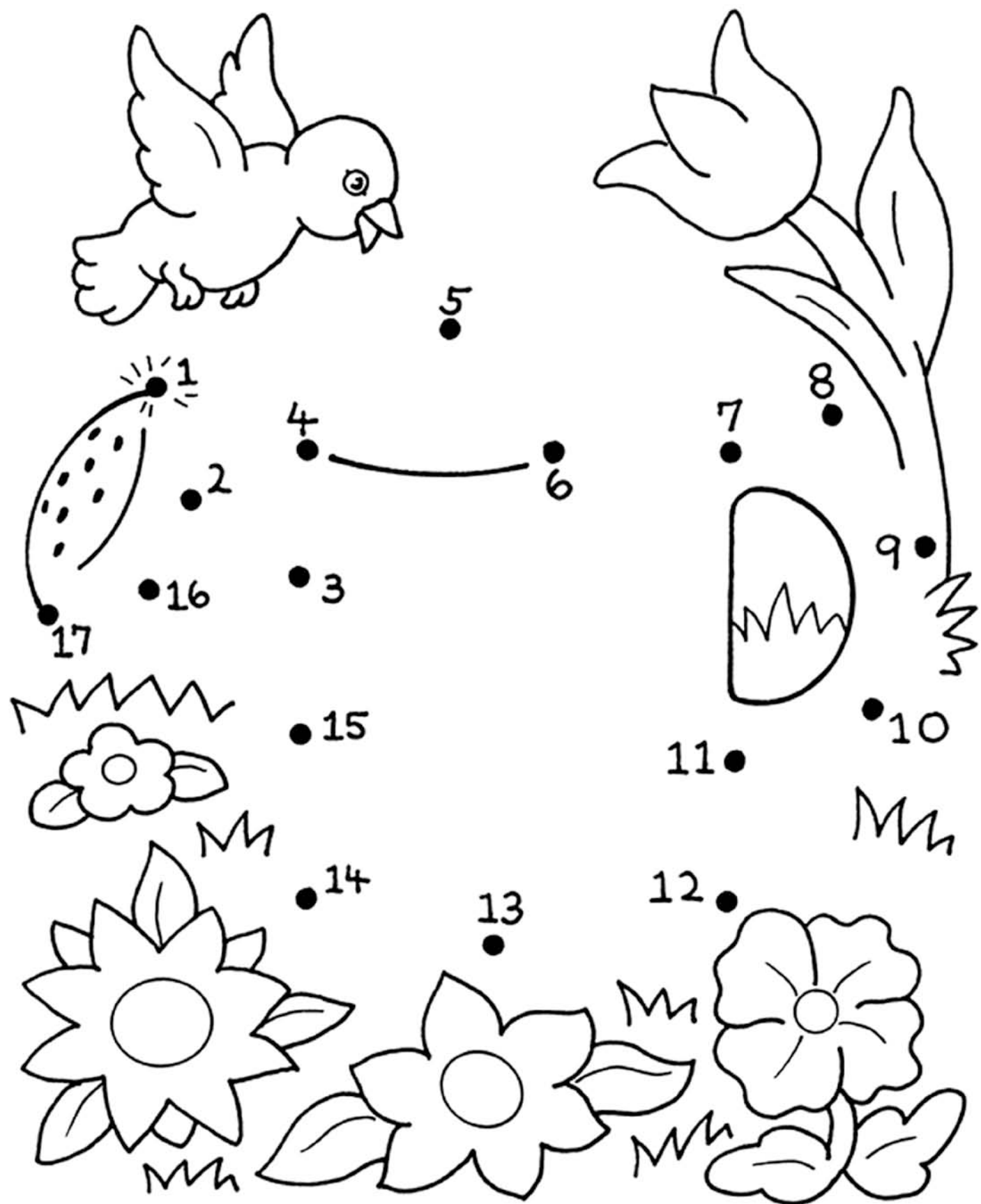

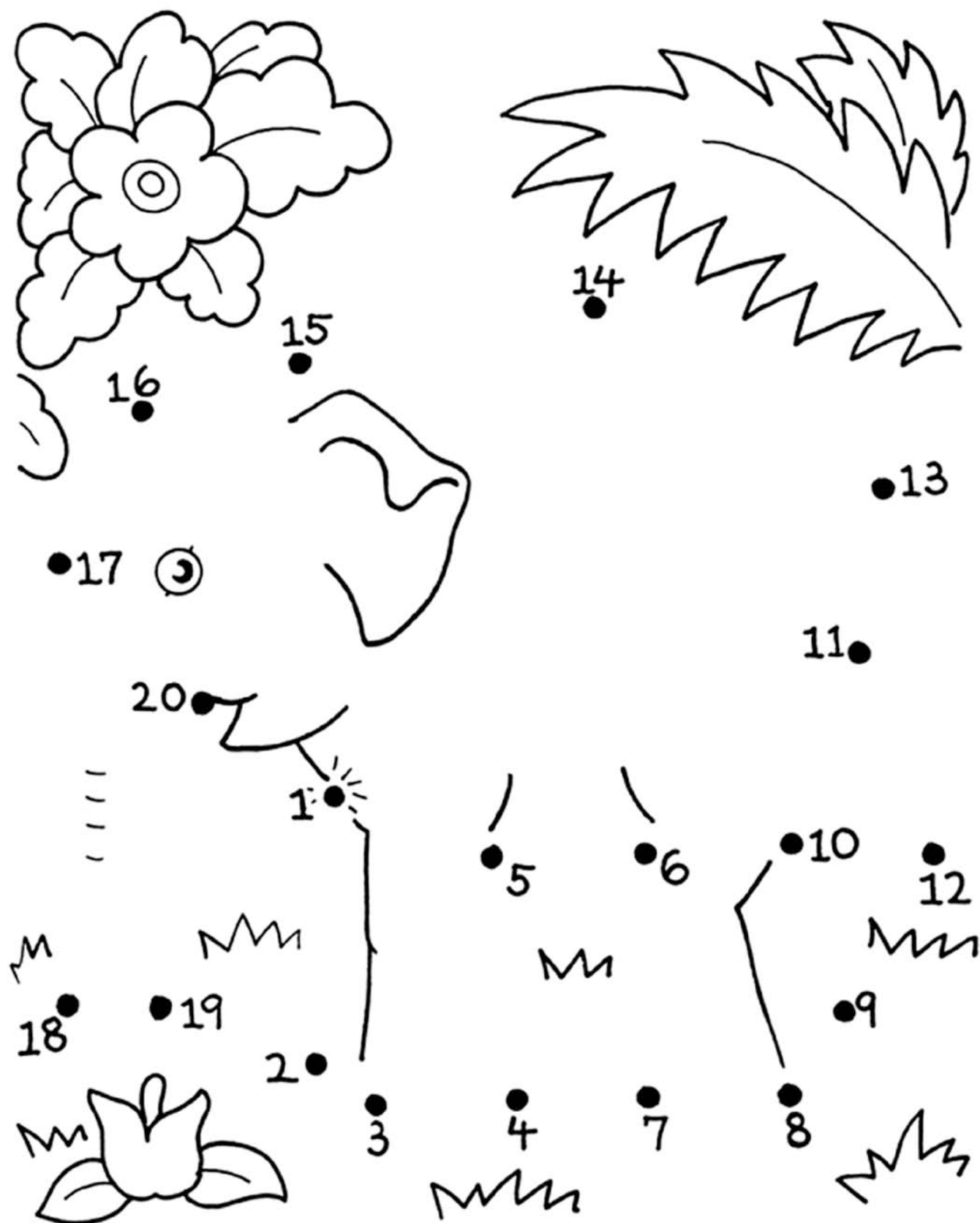
